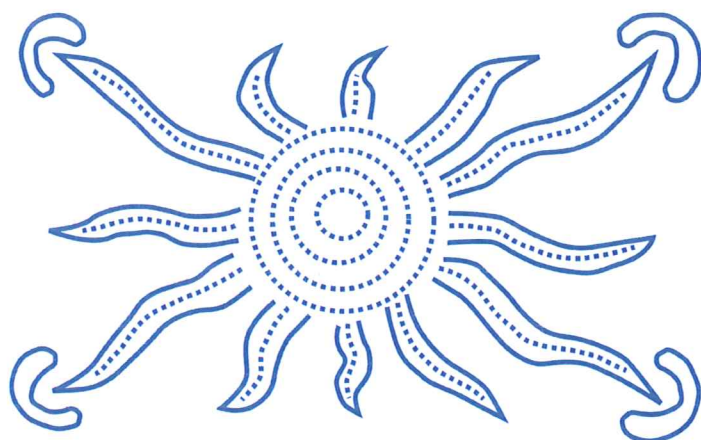

Strategic Priority 1: Achieve improved learning outcomes for students in literacy and numeracy .

Performance Measure

- Achievement of expected NAPLAN means scores
- Increase in percentage of students achieving PAT stanines in reading and numeracy relative to their year level.
